COVERAGE DETAILS

During the term of this maintenance plan, the selling dealer will perform the following maintenance based upon the number of services included as identified on the information schedule.

BREAK IN SERVICE

Includes the break in maintenance as outlined in the manufacturer's maintenance booklet for the vehicle's make, model, and year, subject to the terms, conditions, and limitations listed in your contract.

FULL SERVICE

Includes the full-service maintenance as outlined in the manufacturer's maintenance booklet for the vehicle's make, model, and year, subject to the terms, conditions, and limitations listed in your contract.

OIL SERVICE

Oil services include an oil change with oil filter replacement and chassis lubrication.

SAFETY INSPECTION

Safety inspection includes the inspection of the vehicle's air filter and breather element, exterior lights, head lamps, horn, tire inflation, emergency brake and exhaust system, drive belts, brake hoses, fuel hose; as well as the inspection of levels and topping off of the following: transmission fluid, differential fluid, brake fluid, power steering fluid, and engine coolant.
