UV Body Panel Labels leave a permanent and unique code on your vehicle that is visible under UV light, deterring theft and allowing law enforcement agencies to identify the owner of a recovered vehicle.

BENEFITS

If your vehicle is stolen and not recovered, or if the vehicle is recovered but declared a total loss, you may be eligible for:

- ✔ A benefit to be used toward your purchase or lease of a replacement vehicle; **AND**
- ✔ A benefit to be used toward payment of theft protection expenses, including your primary insurance deductible, rental costs, and travel expenses

Alternatively, if your stolen vehicle is recovered and not declared a total loss, you may be eligible for reimbursement of certain theft protection expenses.
